- 9.45 am** It really is never too early for chocolate! Stop in at the Margaret River Chocolate Company for a free sample, a milk shake for the kids and a coffee for you.
- 10.30 am** Next stop is the WA Reptile Park where you can get up close and personal with snakes, lizards and even a crocodile.
- 11.45 am** Time for a game of Supa Golf where everyone can feel like a champion as this par 3 course uses big clubs and balls. Then take the time to unwind and enjoy a delicious lunch.
- 2.00 pm** Nobody can say no to ice cream so why not stop off and treat the kids at Oggies Ice Creamery.
- 2.30 pm** Now that your kids are fed why not help a farmer feed theirs. Take the family to the Swan Valley Cuddly Animal Farm where you can spend hours feeding the animals, riding the train and having a jump on the bouncy castle.
