### Suggested Itinerary

The award-winning Swan Valley Food and Wine Trail features more than 150 places to eat and drink plus more than 40 seasonal produce stalls. The 32km loop is well sign-posted and works in conjunction with the free fold out guide & maps, which is available from the Swan Valley Visitor Centre in Guildford.

- 9.30 am** Arrive at the Swan Valley Visitor Centre, located in the Old Courthouse in Historic Guildford. Wander round the exhibits to get a sense of the regions viticultural heritage before embarking on your day of indulgence. Don't forget to grab a free Swan Valley Food and Wine Trail map
- 10.15am** One of life's greatest pleasures – chocolate can be sampled at the Margaret River Chocolate Company which makes a great first stop. You can also enjoy a frothy cappuccino, wicked hot chocolate and a slice of heavenly cake to get you in the mood.
- 11.15am** On to Lancaster Wines – voted Australia's Best Cellar Door you will be treated to some great wine and cheese.
- 12.00 pm** Time to stop off and indulge your taste buds with a delicious High Tea at Cape Lavender.
- 12.45pm** Be sure to take some time to explore the strawberry farm and even take home your own punnets of mouth watering, plump strawberries that you have freshly picked yourself.
- 1.15pm** The Swan Valley is renowned for Verdelho, Shiraz and Fortifieds and some of the best are created at Talijangich.
- 1.45pm** Overlooking the vines is the restaurant at Sittella where the chef will tempt your tastebuds with a menu featuring loads of local delights. Take your time and relax on the verandah with a bottle of the famous Sittella Silk.
- 2.30pm** Quick stop at the House of Honey to buy something to put on your hot toast or cereal tomorrow morning.
- 2.45 pm** Much of the character of the Swan Valley comes from its European Heritage. Next stop for the day is Mondo Nougat where you can enjoy an authentic Italian espresso or gelato ice cream.
